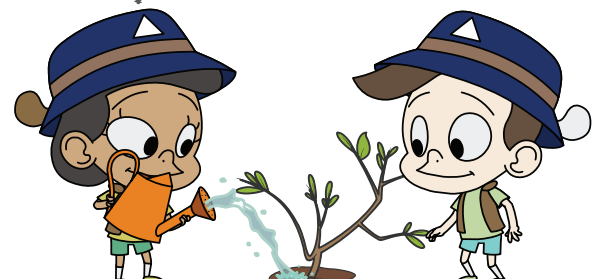

As Scouters, we facilitate a Youth-led program.



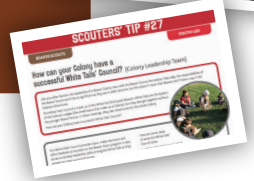
SCOUTERS' ROLE
